Flag/View HistoryIf you progress in the game, you will soon realize that Star Fragment or two need to upgrade the armor to the maximum. To upgrade the ancient armor set pieces (for Guardian Resistance), you need (1) a star fragment and (2) Giant ancient cores for all three parts, hence agriculture must occur. To upgrade your jewelry, you need (10) matching mineral and (1) Star Fragment.Put on Cold Resistance Armor (Snowquill Headress, Snowquill Tunic, Snowquill Tunic) Warp at Hee Vanir Sanctuary (southern shrine atop Duel Peaks) and climb the mountain behind the shrine where the statues are. (If you're not ready to drop an apple in an empty plate in front of one of the statues, do so and get The Seeds of Korok. Stand between the statues and squeeze the fire (drop the tree and flint and hit it with a metal weapon or if you're out of flint hit it with Meteor Rod). Sit down and wait until morning. Then, light it up and sit and wait until the evening. Face west overlooking the Central Hyrule and with Hyrule Castle to the right of the screen. The fragment will fall from the sky between 9 p.m. and 3 a.m. When this happens, Click R to activate the area and then mark it with a pin. Look at the map (-) and find the shrine or tower closest to your pin and warp there. The Star Fragment will remain in place until 5:00 a.m. Run to the fragment and pick it up. If it falls into the water, it's gone forever, so just try again the next night. Repeat until you have the right amount of Star FragmentsRemember that the Central Tower has Guardians at its base, so be careful when warping there. In addition, monsters go out at night, so use a paraglider or switch to a dark set of armor (dark hood, dark tunic, and dark pants) so you can run faster. Fragments of the star are among the rarest and most difficult to find materials in the Legend of zelda: Breath of the Wild. These pieces of soft star are the most valuable items in the game - worth as much as some of the dragon item drops. When you are lucky enough to find them, you will be able to use them in cooking, sell them or give them great fairies to upgrade some of the game's best armor. How to find star fragments If you are very, very lucky, you can stumble upon a fragment of a star in a buried chest. But it doesn't help you as much as you want or need. There is no guaranteed way to find star fragments, but you can improve your chances if you put in a bit of work. And by work we mean sitting and doing nothing. Shooting stars have their unfathomable logic, but there seems to be some rules. They show up at night (obviously) sometime between 9pm and 3am. They fall somewhere in your line of sight - in other words, wherever you look when they appear. This means that you can kind of control where one lands. They may appear any night, but they seem to appear more often during the full moon. (It wasn't our experience, though.) So to maximize the See and then find, a soft star, you need somewhere with a clear line of sight on a relatively open piece of land. Shee Vaneer Shrine fits this bill perfectly - and it's easy to get to since you can travel quickly to it. Now you just have to wait until night. Build a fire and sit on it until nightfall (that 9pm). Climb to the top of the summit, where you have a good view of the sky and the ground below you, and choose the direction. Looking east towards the Hateno Tower and the village works well here. Now wait. And wait. And probably wait a little longer. If all goes well, you will eventually see a soft star. Watch where it lands - it will even have a nice yellow lighthouse. Use your sight to drop the pin (or as close as possible to) the star fragment. You're in a bit of a hurry because the star fragment will disappear at 5 a.m. Travel to the nearest shrine or tower (see that terrain can slow you down a lot), and drink the speed of increasing the elixir if you have. All that's left is to rush to the crash site and pick up your prize. The last hurdle you have to overcome is physics. A fragment of a star will not be subject to gravity rules until you are near it. This means that it can be stuck on the rock until you are close and then it will fall to the ground below. This shouldn't be a problem, but it's something to look out for. If things go wrong your way though - and it happened more often than not while we were experimenting with it - you just have to wait again. Go back to the fire and light it up. Sit on it again until night and repeat the process - choose the direction and wait. I hope you'll be more lucky this time. How to use star fragments You can sell a star fragment for 300 rupees. You can also cook with it. Adding it to a meal will increase the health you get from eating, but not by much. Cooking with a star fragment is pretty much a waste of a super rare item. The most important is the use for upgrading armor and equipment. Things like ancient armor and tiaras and circles you can buy in the city of Gerudo require fragments of stars to upgrade them all the way. The Legend of zelda: Breath of the Wild is packed with secrets and hidden features, some of which are so subtle you may not even notice them until you've passed 50 hours of gameplay (like us). Fragments of stars are one such element. These are precious items that fall from the night sky and can be used in some unique ways. Despite their elusive nature you can farm these rare drops and therefore get some of the best gear - and we're going to show you how it's done. As farm star fragments can farm star fragments in size of about one every five to ten minutes. First, visit any place where you can catch a little sleep (fire or cooking pot over Stables is a good choice because it is free). Sleep until morning and then manually save your game. Once you've done that, click Home and close the game down Open it again, re-load the save and then sleep until nightfall. Once you've done that, teleport to a high place - in this case, we use The Hee Wanir Sanctuary at Duelling Peaks. Once you are there, make sure you have warm clothes as it is quite cold. You may also have to deal with some enemies as well. When you have the top of the mountain to yourself, look east, towards the tower of Hateno. Between the hours of 9pm and 12pm, you should see the shooting star drift in from the top of the screen. Watch where it lands - as soon as it hits the ground it will emit a shaft of light. Use your sight to determine the exact location and lay the marker pin that appears on your mini-map. Once you've done it all, either paragliding from the top of the mountain to the pin, or teleport to the nearest temple. You can repeat this process as many times as you want. Closing the game and restarting seems to reset the internal clock of the game, allowing you to get more star fragments than you would through a normal game. What fragments of stars are used for there are three main uses for star fragments as soon as you have them. First, it is their resale value; If you are looking to raise some cash quickly then you will be glad to know that they cost 300 rupees each. You can also use them in cooking, but we wouldn't advise against it - the efficiency resulting in the dish is not all that great compared to the mighty Hearty Radish, and while you can sell dishes for a nice profit, it's not really worth the fuss. The third and final use for Star Fragments is to upgrade some of the items and armor (mostly those that got with amiibo) to the maximum that you need to make by visiting one of the four Great Fairies in the game. The following elements can be updated with the help of star fragments: Ancient Greaves Topaz Earrings Diamond Tiara Ruby necklace Sapphire Circlet Cap of the Sky (amiibo item) Tunic Sky (amiibo item) Sky pants (amiibo item) Time cover (amiibo item) Tunic time (amiibo item) Time pants (amiibo item) Twilight (3 pointamiibo) Cap of the Wild (amiibo item) Tunic of the Wild (amiibo item) Wildlife pants (tem amiibo) Cap of the Wind (item amiibo) Tunic of the Wind (item amiibo) Wind (item amiibo) Cap of the Hero (amiibo item) Tunic of the Hero (amiibo item) especially if you need to raise a lot of money. It's a shame that they can't be used to enhance more items - those of you without amiibo can't see the point of collecting them - but they're worth grabbing when they appear.
